## The value of the Nelson Mandela legacy for South Africa. (Afrikaans below)

A good question is half of wisdom says Francis Bacon. I had a question yesterday during a Zoom session with a congregation in the USA, "Why are you doing what you do? And why do you put so much emphasis on the Mandela legacy?"

The project, [Long Walk for the Entrepreneurial Mindset](#) provided a couple of insights for me. Most important the value of the Mandela legacy as our most valuable social asset and at the same time that this legacy is underutilized in current times. This realization was confirmed in my relation and communication with the Nelson Mandela Foundation.

When I was told by an international visitors' group that they came to South Africa to learn about peace and forgiveness, it made me to realize that we should not overlook the value of this legacy. When I saw the reaction of 16-year-old teenagers across South Africa during the Long Walk, when I imitated the voice of Nelson Mandela, I just became more and more under the impression of the value of the legacy in terms of social context. The same happened during speaker opportunities in Russia, USA, Malta, Tunisia, Canada, etc.

What then is the value of the Nelson Mandela legacy? To my opinion it is the strongest unifier among the diverse cultural groups in South Africa. The effect is that it takes us back in a moment to a time when we were all filled with hope and positive expectations about the future. The legacy has a strengthening effect on our identity, of who we are. A nation that came together and achieved the impossible, against all odds. This was seen by the world as a miracle. When we focus on the legacy it creates an alternative to the lack of trust and disappointments, we had to endure the last couple of years and which became our current paradigm of thinking in South Africa.

Therefore, my focus became the Nelson Mandela legacy and I aligned all my actions and interventions accordingly. This is now captured in the "Be a Nelson" project of which the symbolic walk on the UN declared [International Nelson Mandela Day](#), July 18<sup>th</sup>, forms part of. ## Die waarde van die Nelson Mandela erfenis vir Suid-Afrika.

'n Goeie vraag is die helfte van wysheid sê Francis Bacon. Ek kry gister die slim vraag tydens 'n Zoom sessie met 'n kerk in Amerika. "Hoekom doen jy wat jy doen? Hoekom fokus jy so sterk op die Mandela erfenis?"

Die projek, [Long Walk for the Entrepreneurial Mindset](#) het 'n paar insigte meegebring. Een daarvan is hoe sterk die Mandela erfenis is en dat dit waarskynlik ons mees waardevolle sosiaal-motiverende besitting is wat tans onderbenut word. Die onderbenutting is ook my gewaarwording in my verhouding en kommunikasie met die Nelson Mandela Foundation.

Wanneer 'n internasionale besoekers groep vir my sê, "ons het Suid-Afrika toe gekom om te leer van vrede en vergifnis", het dit my laat wonder of ons genoeg maak van waar die boodskap vandaan kom? Wanneer ek die reaksie gesien het van 16-jariges in townships reg deur Suid-Afrika wanneer ek Mandela se stem na-maak, en so kan ek aangaan en aangaan. Dieselfde geld vir ervarings in die buiteland as spreker in Rusland, Amerika, Malta, Tunisië en Kanada,

Wat is dan die waarde van die Nelson Mandela erfenis? Dit is die grootste saambindende faktor tussen alle Suid-Afrikaners. Die herinnering neem Suid-Afrikaners terug na 'n tyd toe almal met hoop en

positiewe verwagtings vervuld was. Dit is 'n versterking van ons identiteit as mense wat die onmoontlike kan vermag teen alle verwagtings in en wat deur die wêreld van toe af tot nou gesien is as 'n wonderwerk. Wanneer ons hierop fokus skep dit 'n positiewe alternatief vir die wantroue en teleurstelling wat die huidige denk-paradigma geword het onder alle Suid-Afrikaners.

Daarom is my fokus op die Mandela erfenis tema en het ek al my aksies en insette belyn in terme van die "Be a Nelson" projek. Die simboliese stap op die UN verklaarde [International Nelson Mandela Day, July 18<sup>th</sup>](#), vorm dus deel hiervan. Meer oor die "Be a Nelson" projek in die volgende uitgawe.
